

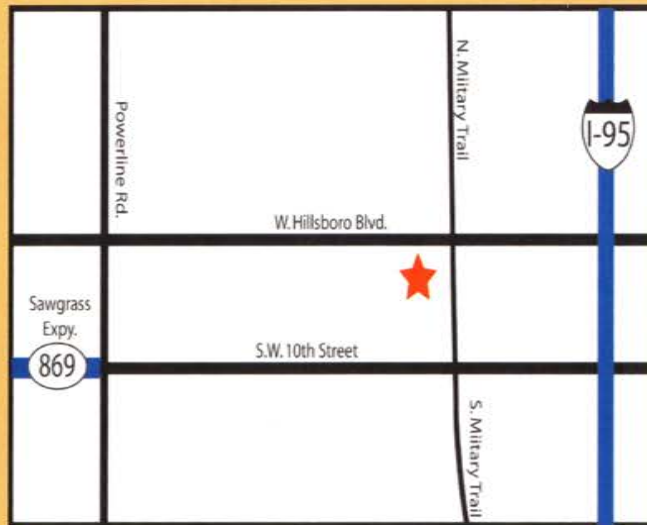

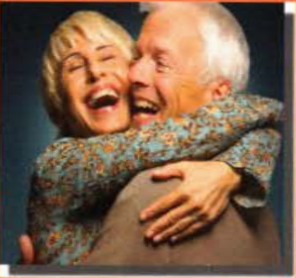

THE POWER OF HBOT BEGINS WITH H.O.P.E.

Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy, (HBOT) is a medical procedure that is accepted by the FDA and Medicare to treat certain conditions with the use of pure medical grade oxygen at increased atmospheric pressures. The need for HBOT and the ongoing research is rapidly being recognized and regarded as mainstream medicine.



During therapy the patient spends a prescribed amount of time in a cylindrical acrylic chamber receiving pure oxygen while being monitored under meticulous conditions.

The therapy plan, which includes depth of pressure, length of treatment time and frequency of treatment is prescribed by the Hyperbaric Physician for each patient's particular needs.

HBOT has produced astonishing results in a broad range of acute and chronic conditions



WOUND CARE

The healing of wounds is becoming a growing medical specialty. There are many different kinds of non-healing wounds including diabetic ulcers, pressure ulcers, wounds caused by trauma and ulcers caused by poor circulation.

It is often frustrating and time consuming to heal these wounds.

Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy can often shorten the time for wounds to heal and in most cases allows closure of a non-healing wound that in the past may have required surgery or amputation.
